Purity And Strength

Piero Incisa della Rocchetta, whose family owns Sassicaia on the Tuscan coast, founded Bodega Chacra to focus on pinot noir from old vines in Mainque, in Patagonia's Río Negro. He works with winemaker Hans Vinding Diers to capture the purity and strength of pinot, even in this entry-level wine. Vivid in cherry and raspberry flavors—plus some black pepper—zippy in acidity and tannins, this feels energetic and crunchy, with an accent of earthy notes revealed at the end.
